<p>God having out of his mere good pleasure, from all eternity, elected some to everlasting life, did enter into a covenant of grace to deliver them out of the state of sin and misery, and to bring them into a state of SALVATION by a Redeemer.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> Eph 1:4; 2 Tim 1:9; Rom 9:11-20; John 15:16; Acts 13:48</p>	<p>The only redeemer of God's elect is the Lord Jesus Christ, who being the eternal Son of God, became man, and so was and continues to be God and man, in two distinct natures and one person forever.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> Matt. 1:21; Luke 19:10; Gal 1:3,4; Titus 2:14 John 10:11; John 17; Eph 1:3-12</p>	<p>Effectual calling is the work of God's Spirit, whereby, convincing us of our sin and misery, enlightening our minds in the knowledge of the Christ, and renewing our wills, He persuades and enables us to embrace Jesus Christ freely offered to us in the gospel.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> John 1:12,13; John 3:3-8; 1 Pet 1:23; Eze 36:26,27; Eph 2:1,5</p>	<p>Repentance unto life is a saving grace, whereby a sinner, out of a true sense of his sin and apprehension of the mercy of God in Christ, does with grief and hatred of his sin turn from it to God, with full purpose to strive after new obedience.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> Acts 5:31; Acts 11:18; 2 Tim 2:25,26; Acts 3:19; Luke 24:47</p>	<p>Faith in Jesus Christ is a saving grace whereby we receive and rest upon Him alone for salvation, as He is set forth in the gospel.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> Acts 18:27; Eph 2:8,9; Phil 1:29</p>	<p>Justification is an act of God's free grace wherein he pardons all our sins, and accepts us as righteous in his sight, only for the righteousness of Christ imputed to us and received by faith alone.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> Rom 5:1,10,19; Rom 8:1; Rom 1-3; Rom 8:29-30,33; 2 Cor 5:21; Gal 2:16; Phil 3:9; Titus 3:7</p>	<p>Adoption is an act of God's free grace whereby we are received into the number, and have a right to all the privileges, of the sons of God.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> 1 John 3:1; John 1:12,13; Rom 8:17,15,23; Gal 4:5; Eph 1:5</p>	<p>Sanctification is a work of God's Spirit, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin and live unto righteousness.</p> <p><b>Baptist Catechism</b> 2 Peter 3:18; Heb 10:14; 1 Pet 1:15; 1 Pet 5:10; Rom 6:10,11,22; 1 Thes 5:23</p>	<p>Glorification is the culmination of salvation and is the final blessed and abiding state of the redeemed.</p> <p><b>Baptist Faith and Message</b> Jude 24,25; John 3:16-18; John 5:24; Rom 8:28-30,35-39; Eph 1:3,13,14; Col 3:3,4; 1 Thes 5:23,24; Heb 4:9, 9:28</p>
